

Kennedy Clan; Annual Gathering 2017.


The 2017 Clan Gathering in Chief Rody's in Rearcross was a hugely enjoyable and informative gathering. Kennedys gathered from far and near to chat, reminisce, share photos and memorabilia, and learn more about our Kennedy history. Brian, our author, historian, seanchai and all round guru gave an illustrated talk on the one thousand year history of the Kennedys in Upper and Lower Ormond and their status as Lords of Ormond up to the 1600's.

This was followed by Professor Mark Kennedy from Victoria, Australia with a very interesting presentation on D.N.A. and its role in providing proof of some of the links that may be missing from available records.

New and old members mingled happily as they partook of Rody and Ann's hospitality with many already clearing their calendars in preparation for the 2018 gathering.

The 1st port of call was Ballinaclough Graveyard. Michael Kennedy of Addane talked about the history of the Kennedy families buried in Ballinaclough and noted that many of the Upper Ormond Kennedys continued to bring their loved ones down from the mountains to be buried here and in nearby Kilkeary, with their ancestors from pre Cromwellian times.

Nearby we visited Cloghenane Castle later known as Castle Otway having been taken from the Kennedys and granted to Cromwellian officer Capt. Otway.
